

**GRANT FROM THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED PORT DISTRICT
STREAM TEAM STEWARDS
PROGRESS REPORT
APRIL 1, 2009**

Description of Work Completed:

Preliminary planning steps were initiated from the months of January to March 2009 for the Stream Team Stewards project funded by the San Diego Unified Port District. A preparation timeline has been outlined to launch Stream Team Stewards in September 2009. (Please see attached.) 10% of the project has been completed to date, with the expected project completion date set for December 12, 2009.

The project coordinator began implementing the preparation tasks such as completing subcontract agreements and marketing the Stream Team Stewards project to San Diego City schools. To date, the Zoo's Conservation Education Specialist has committed 20 hours toward the planning activities, totaling \$800 (20 hours at \$40 per hour) of in-kind labor costs.

San Diego Zoo staff has also met with students from the California Art Institute of San Diego to design the Stream Team logo and the educational materials for the program. These materials include a community brochure/invasive plant guide, desktop name cards, and classroom posters. We have enclosed rough drafts of these materials for your review. The San Diego Unified Port District will be acknowledged on these materials.

Five school sites have committed to participate in the Stream Team Stewards program. These include Holly Drive Leadership Academy, Promise Charter, Balboa Elementary, Baker Elementary, and Perkins Elementary Schools. The project coordinator will meet with the school contacts in early summer 2009 to confirm program dates. One additional school site will be selected this spring to join the Stream Team Stewards program.

Anticipated work for the next reporting period:

In April, the Stream Team Stewards' collaborating organizations will meet to review the restoration component of the program and begin purchasing supplies for the program. Additionally, the curriculum materials will be developed and completed. The program coordinator will provide the Stream Team Stewards curriculum to the school sites at the date setting meeting in June. We will include the materials in the next progress report.

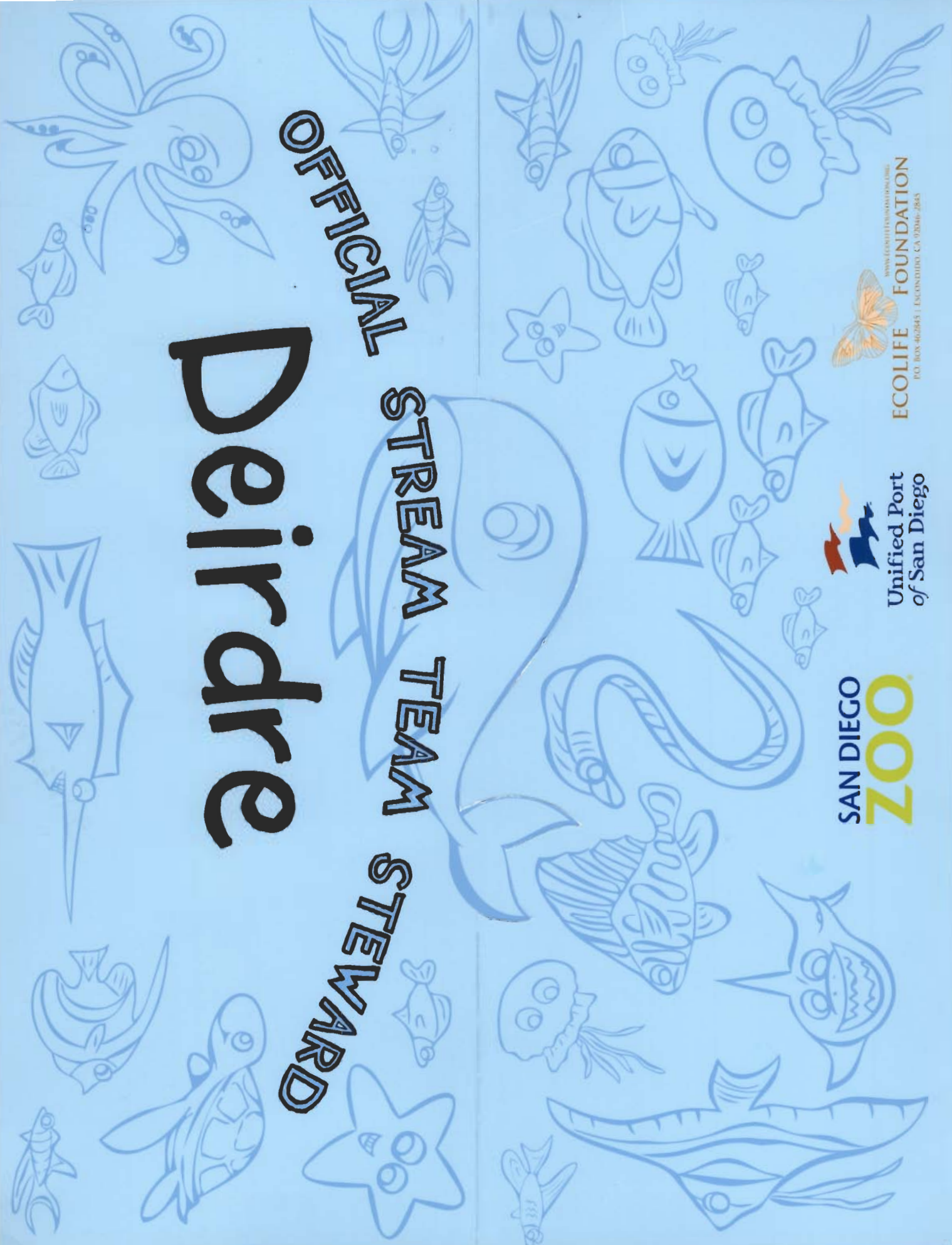
In May and June, the Stream Team Stewards collaborators will develop the bilingual text for the community brochure; work with the art students to complete the brochure, name cards, and educational materials. In June, the Zoo's Conservation Education Specialist will work with the school representatives to finalize the program dates and details.
