 - 30% Reduction Possible
- Water Wise Plants
 - 60% Reduction with Mature Developed Root System
 - Elimination of Ornamental Annuals.
- Artificial Turf

 - Fixing Malfunctioning Irrigation Equipment
- Stress Watering
- Being a Good Citizen
 - Reporting Leaks, Problems and Excessive Irrigation
