



## **White Seabass Restocking Project June 2010 Quarterly Report**

SDOF provides the White Seabass Restocking Project & Research Project in grow-out pens in San Diego Bay off Harbor Drive that have a capacity of 40,000 fish.

On May 21, HUBBS delivers two groups of white seabass to the pens in San Diego Bay.

### **Quarter highlights and progress:**

- New fish are delivered in May 2010
  - (up to 40,000 fish)
- 3 pen cleaning
  - (32 volunteers for 18 hours)
- Hosted White Seabass Hatchery Tour on March 31<sup>st</sup>
  - (28 participants)
- Performed updated maintenance
- Recruiting and train volunteers through orientations
  - (650 people have signed up and are interested in helping WSB)
- Replenished more supplies (gloves, nets, cables, trash cans)
- Attended outreach events to educate the public about WSB
  - EarthFair (Thousands attended)
  - Earth Day Green Event (Hundreds attended)
  - Life Technologies Outreach Event (Hundreds attended)
- Continued Adopt A White Seabass educational program and fundraiser
  - 12 elementary schools (345 students)
  - Membership clubs (diving group and photo society)
  - Promoting through Dive-A-Thon Fundraiser

### **Current problems or needs:**

- The old oil boom needs to be replaced
- Need to look into a dock joint to increase safety

### **Activities planned for next quarter:**

- Continue to recruit and train new volunteers
- Administer 1 pen cleaning & 4 orientations each month
- Educate the community on the project and continue to build relationships with Port Tenants
