THIS CERTIFICATE IS SUBJECT TO SECTION #8.02 OF THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED PORT DISTRICT CODE, WHICH INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS AND RESTRICTIONS:

8.02(e)1

... Only an individual is eligible for a Certificate and no Certificate shall be approved or issued for any group, association, corporation or any other entity.

... The application shall be reviewed and approved or rejected within Five (5) working days...

8.02(e)2

A Certificate shall be for a Six (6) month period...

- a) No entertainer shall perform in any park area without a Certificate having been approved and issued...
- b) The entertainer to whom the Certificate is issued must have an original signed Certificate in his or her possessions while performing, and present it to a District employee upon request.
- c) **ONLY NON-COMMERCIAL ACTIVITY IS ALLOWED. SALE OF MERCHANDISE IS PROHIBITED.**
- d) A **SINGLE SIGN** 5" x 7" in size, stating "**DONATIONS ONLY**" may be posted at the performance area. **NO OTHER SIGNS** shall be erected or posted publicizing the activity or performance.

There shall be **NO FEE OR DONATION CHARGED, REQUIRED, OR SOLICITED**, however, accepting donations is permitted.

- e) No sound amplification of any type shall be permitted. Percussion and brass instruments are not permitted.
- f) Any litter generated in or about the performance area during and immediately preceding and subsequent to any performance shall be immediately removed from the park area by the entertainer.
- g) No improvements or equipment shall be made to or installed in any area.
- h) Any damage resulting from any performance shall be repaired at the expense of the entertainer.

- i) No performance is permitted which poses a threat or inherent risk of damage to property or injury to the entertainer or the public.
- j) No performance is permitted in any specific area during the time for which a permit is issued to another person, group or entity.
- k) An entertainer shall not substantially interfere with any governmental function, event or activity, nor substantially interrupt the safe and orderly use of any park area by the public or obstruct the orderly movement of pedestrian or vehicular traffic in any park area. In the event or any such interference or interruption, the performance shall immediately cease and the entertainer(s) disband.
- l) No performance is permitted from Sunset until 9:00 a.m.
- m) Noise regulations of the District member City in which the performance occurs are applicable and shall be complied with by any entertainer.

8.02(e)3

An entertainer shall not perform at any time in the following described areas:

- a) In Embarcadero Marina Park North, on the lawn area adjacent to the boardwalk immediately south of Harbor House Restaurant in Seaport Village, except for on position each at the corners of the lawn area adjacent to the waterfront boardwalk and adjacent to the sidewalk at Kettner Boulevard.
- b) In the Gazebo at the Embarcadero Marina Park North.
- c) Adjacent to the sidewalk which enters the northeasterly edge of Embarcadero Marina Park South, except for one position each on the grass at the entrance to the Park and on the grass where the sidewalk turns northwesterly at a 90-degree angle.
- d) On the basketball court or in the kiosk in the Embarcadero Marina Park South.
- e) Along Harbor Drive, between Broadway and G Street, except for on position on the boardwalk at the northerly side of the entrance to Tuna Harbor.
- f) In the public plaza area at the northwesterly corner of Tuna harbor.
- g) In the Rotary Pavilion and within the traffic circle which contains the Friendship Bell at the southwesterly tip of Shelter Island.
- h) On the sidewalks or in the spectator areas near the ball fields in Coronado Tidelands Park.
- i) On the public beach areas at Shelter Island and the Chula Vista Bayside Park.

8.02(e)5

Any violation of law or of any of the regulations or provisions of this Subsection (e) committed by any entertainer in the park area during the period for which a Certificate is valid, shall be grounds for termination of Certificate. In addition, it is grounds to reject approving sa future Certificate until after Six (6) month period after such termination.

This application is submitted pursuant to the San Diego unified Port District Code, Section 8.02(e) 1. I understand that any Certificate approved and issued shall be subject to the regulations contained in UPD Code Section #'s 8.02(e) 2,3 and 5, as specified above and I agree to obey such regulations.
