- **Chollas Creek** - Chollas Creek (for 18 years and older- wear work boots) Meet at Pacific Ship Repair and Fabrication 1625 Rigel St., San Diego. **7:00 am start time**
- **Cesar Chavez Park** - is located on Cesar Chavez Parkway and Crosby Road in San Diego (this is a family friendly clean-up site). **8:30 am start time**
- **South-Bay** - National City Marine Terminal and Pepper Park (Volunteer Registration at Pier 32 Marina) **8:00 am start time**

WHO: All volunteers interested in respecting Our Waters

- Divers - Civilian divers join Navy divers in collecting trash from the bottom of San Diego Bay
- Boaters - Boaters and other volunteers collect debris floating on San Diego Bay
- Walkers - Volunteers pick up trash along our water's edge of San Diego Bay
